Environmental Footprint

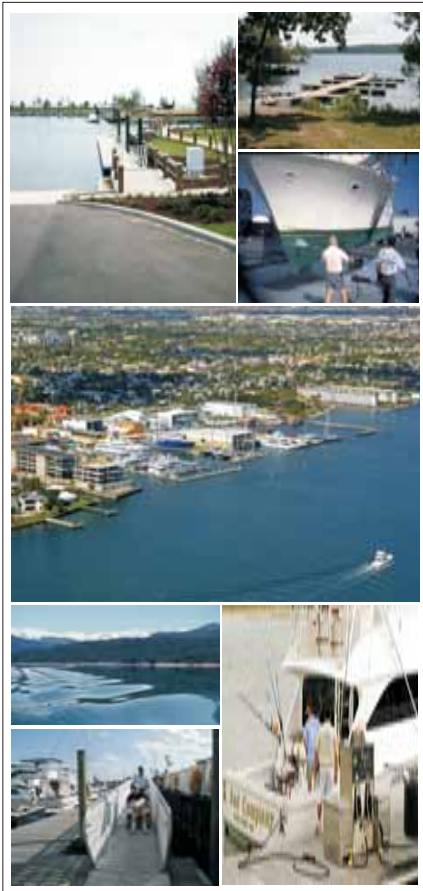
Reduce environmental impact. Plan a water neutral site. Renovate with tested components. Inspect and audit marina structures.
